Today, Dalian iron ore futures continued to fluctuate upward. The most-traded I2505 contract closed at 817 yuan/mt, up 0.86% for the day. Traders sold goods based on market trends, while steel mills purchased as needed, with inquiries decreasing compared to the past two days. Market transactions were moderate today. In Shandong, mainstream transaction prices for PB fines were at 805-808 yuan/mt, stable compared to yesterday. In Tangshan, PB fines transaction prices were around 820-825 yuan/mt, up by 0.5 yuan/mt from yesterday. As of February 7, according to SMM data, total inventory at 35 ports reached 149.91 million mt, up 4.63 million mt from pre-holiday levels and up 23.65 million mt YoY. The daily port pick-up volume of imported ore averaged 2.584 million mt, down 610,000 mt from pre-holiday levels and down 350,000 mt YoY. This week, affected by the Chinese New Year holiday, steel mills suspended restocking during the holiday, leading to a significant decrease in port pick-up volumes and a noticeable accumulation of port inventories. Looking ahead to next week, post-holiday restocking by steel mills is expected to boost port pick-up volumes, which may result in a decline in port inventories. In the short term, the

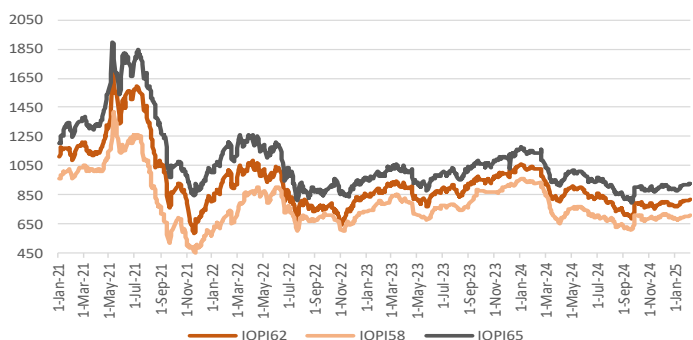

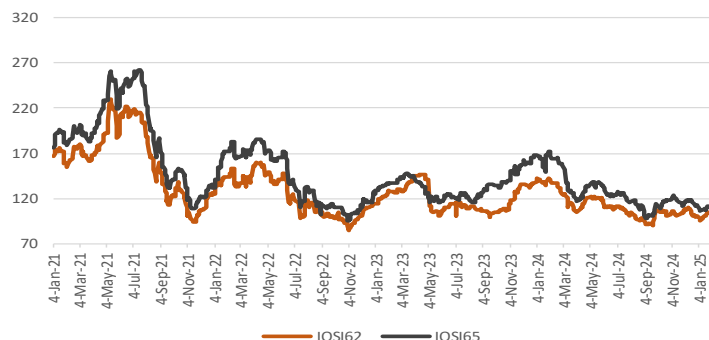

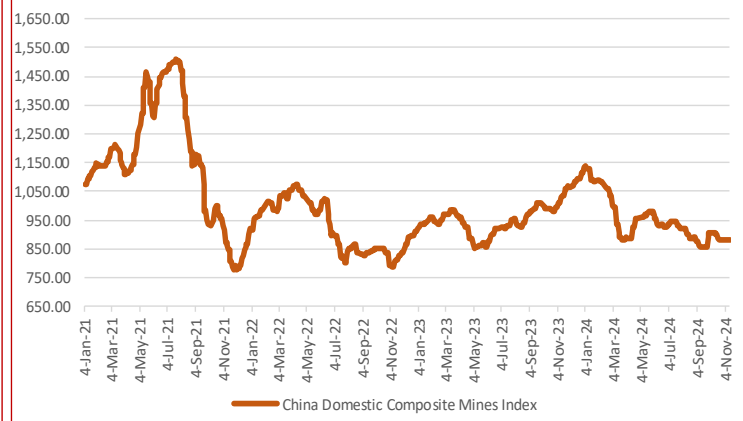

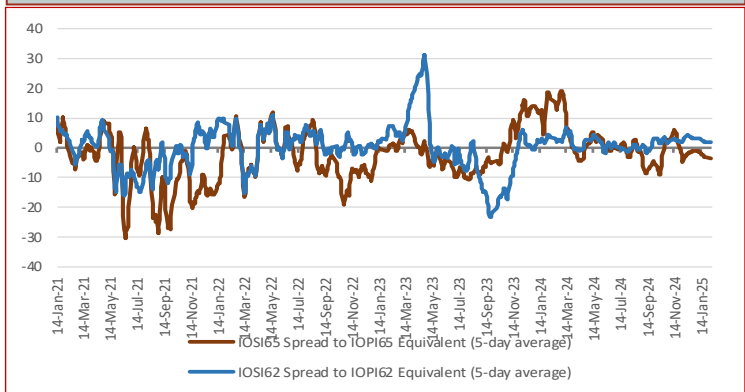

WEEKLY IRON ORE PORT STOCK LUMP PREMIUM (RMB/DMTU)



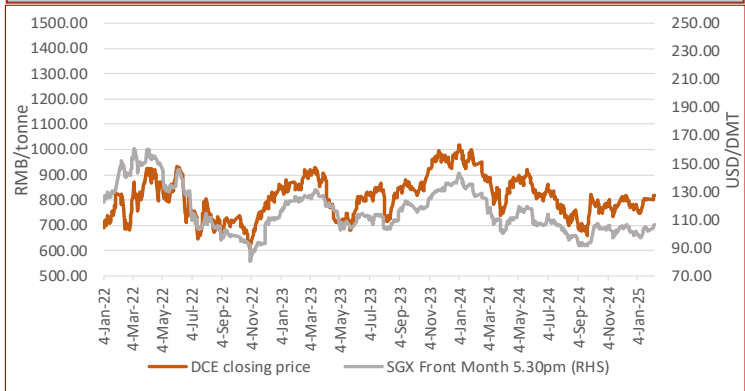

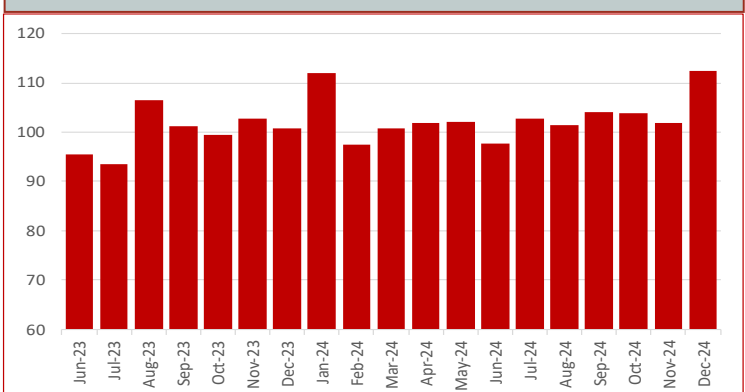

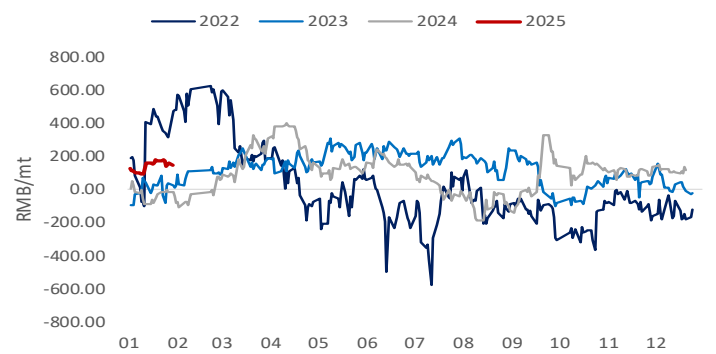
CHINESE STEEL MILL PROFITABILITY



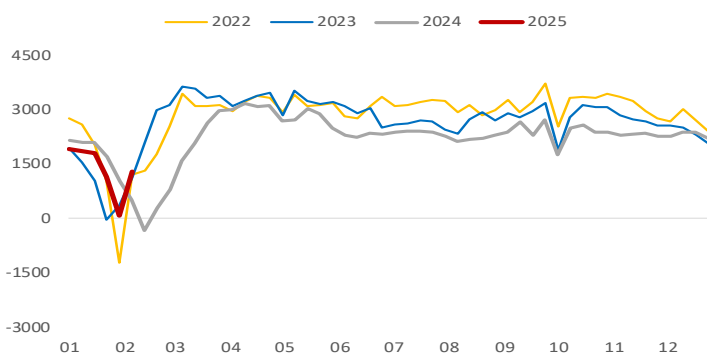
CHINESE STEEL MILL PROFITABILITY—Rebar



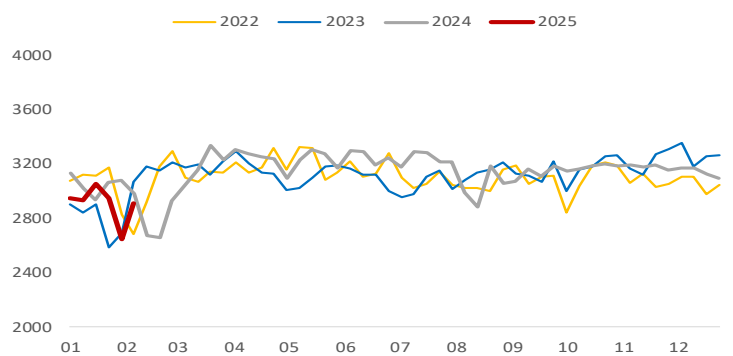
CHINESE STEEL MILL PROFITABILITY—Hot-rolled Coil



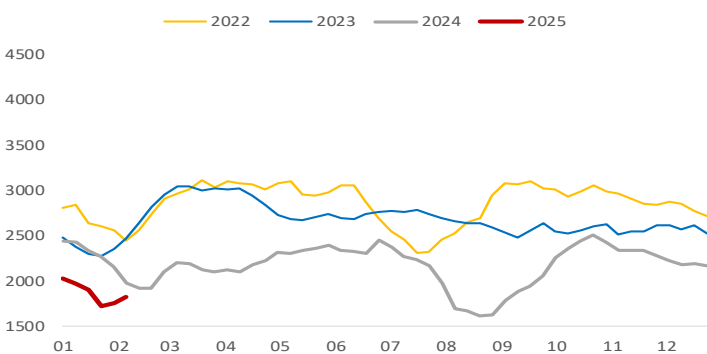

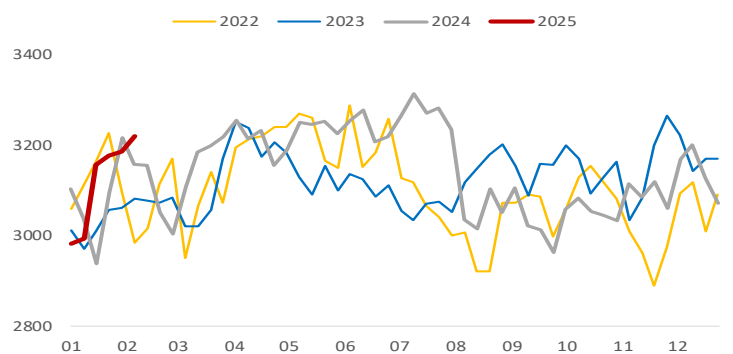

The compilation method for price index generally refers to the compilation method of CPI price index and other price indices, breakdown the price data and calculate the average value according to a certain method, taking the vertical axis as the regional composite index (average of different grade index) and the horizontal axis as the grade composite index (average of different regional index), a total composite index for domestic ore can be output ultimately. The process system is also adopted in the calculation i.e. each sub-index can be obtained as well.
