MARKET COMMENTARY

May 22nd, 2025		CFR Qingdao, USD/dry tonne							Today, the DCE iron ore futures market fluctuated rangebound, with the most-traded contract I2509 eventually closing at 727, up 0.14% for the day. Traders showed moderate enthusiasm for selling, with some offering goods at lower prices; steel mills purchased as needed. The market transaction sentiment was moderate. In the Shandong region, the mainstream transaction prices of P8 fines ranged from 760 to 765 yuan/mt, down 0 to 5 yuan/mt from yesterday's prices. In the Tangshan region, the transaction price of P8 fines was around 775 yuan/mt, basically flat compared to yesterday's prices. Today, the apparent demand for the five major steel products declined slightly. Total inventory continued to decline. The supply-demand imbalance is accumulating, but the pressure is relatively small. In addition, the State Council held a press conference today, and market expectations are positive, with optimistic sentiment. Ore prices continued to hold up well. Considering the healthy fundamentals of iron ore in the short term, with ore prices facing upward and downward pressures, it is expected that ore prices will maintain a narrow rangebound fluctuation in the short term.

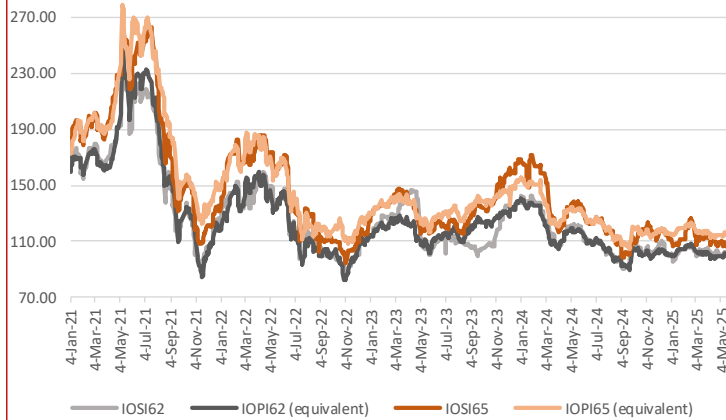

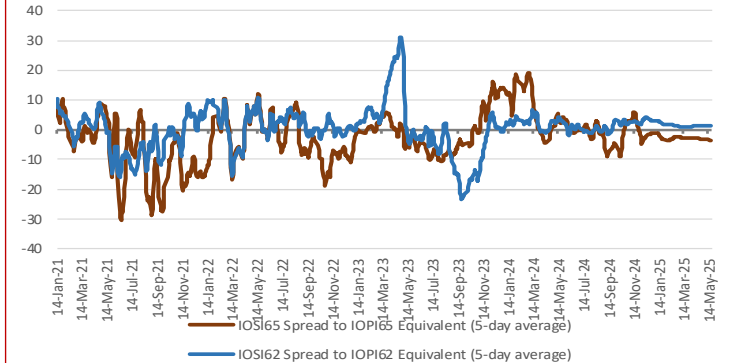

WEEKLY IRON ORE PORT STOCK LUMP PREMIUM (RMB/DMTU)



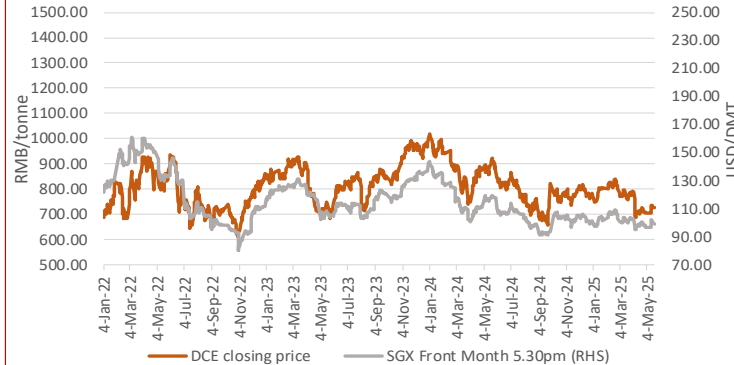
IRON ORE SEABORNE TO PORT STOCK PRICE SPREADS (USD/DMT)

IRON ORE DOMESTIC CONCENTRATE INDEX CALCULATION METHODOLOGY

The compilation method for price index generally refers to the compilation method of CPI price index and other price indices, breakdown the price data and calculate the average value according to a certain method, taking the vertical axis as the regional composite index (average of different grade index) and the horizontal axis as the grade composite index (average of different regional index), a total composite index for domestic ore can be output ultimately. The process system is also adopted in the calculation i.e. each sub-index can be obtained as well.
