Traders are optimistic about the market outlook and are actively selling; however, steel mills are cautiously observing, resulting in a decrease in inquiries. The market trading atmosphere was moderate today. In Shanghai, the mainstream transaction price for PB fines were 790-795 yuan/mt, up 10 yuan/mt compared to last Friday, in Tangshan, the transaction price for PB fines was 805 yuan/mt, also up 10 yuan/mt compared to last Friday.

Both Australia and Brazil saw increases in total shipments, but the proportion shipped to China slightly decreased. Additionally, due to previous shipment declines and domestic weather impacts, SMM reported China's total iron ore arrivals at 25 million mt, down 5.27% WoW. In the short term, the market may continue to operate at low levels. However, as the meeting approaches, market expectations for the meeting are growing stronger, driving iron ore prices to continue rising. In the short term, the market may continue to fluctuate upward.

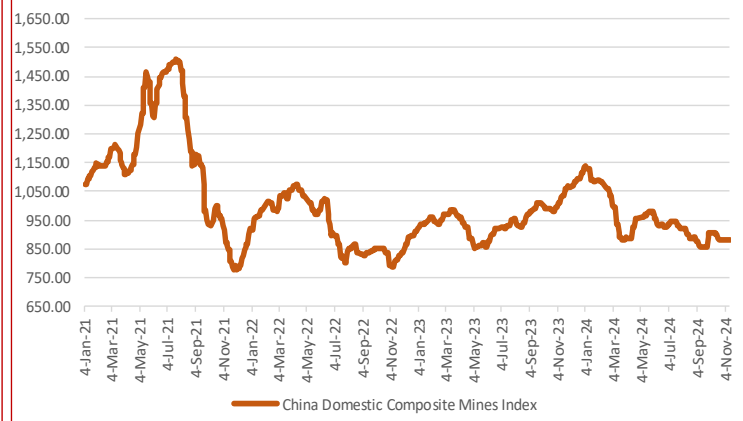

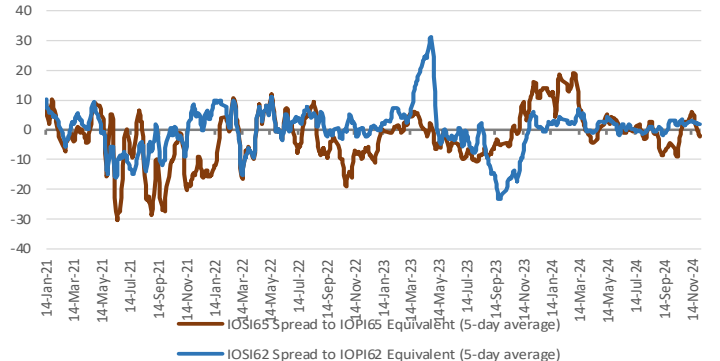

WEEKLY IRON ORE PORT STOCK LUMP PREMIUM (RMB/DMTU)



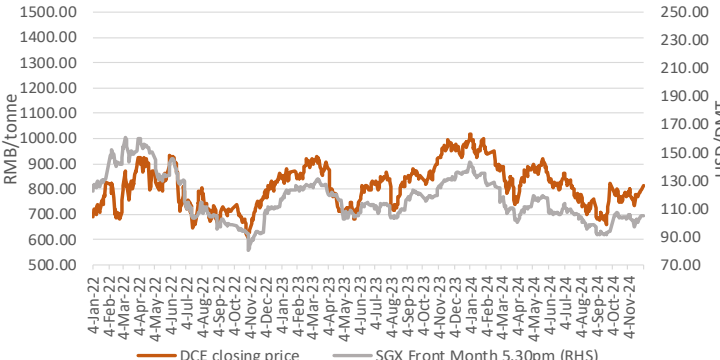
IRON ORE SEABORNE TO PORT STOCK PRICE SPREADS (USD/DMT)

FUTURE TRADING—FRONT MONTH CLOSING PRICE



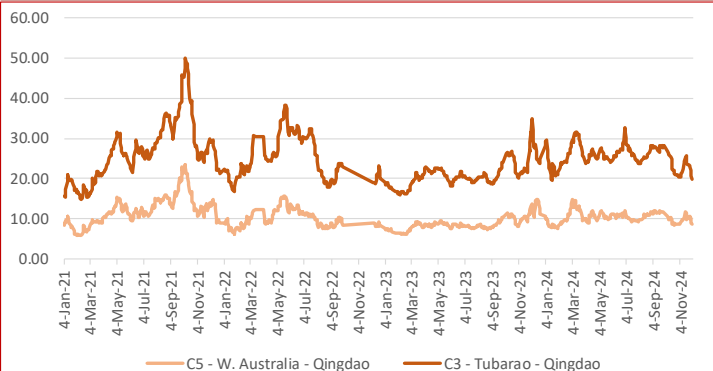

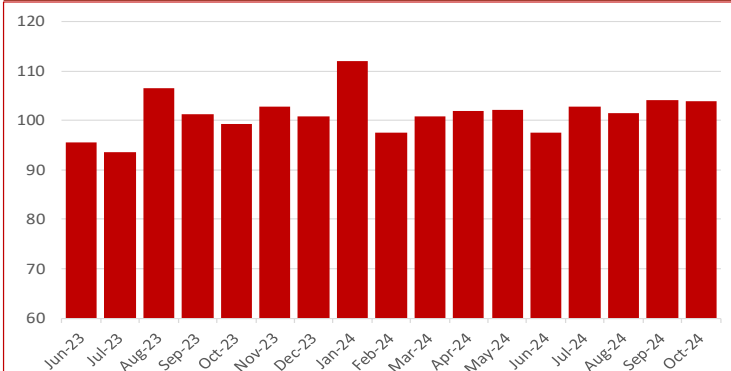

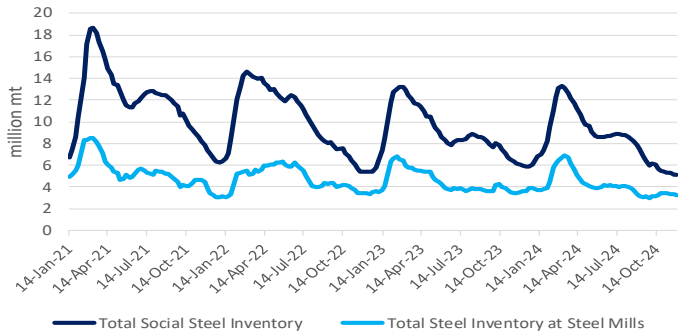

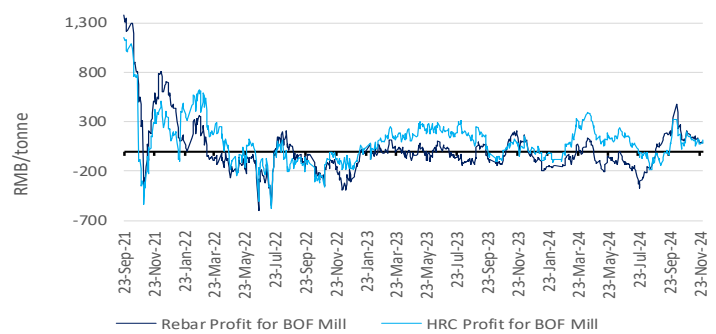

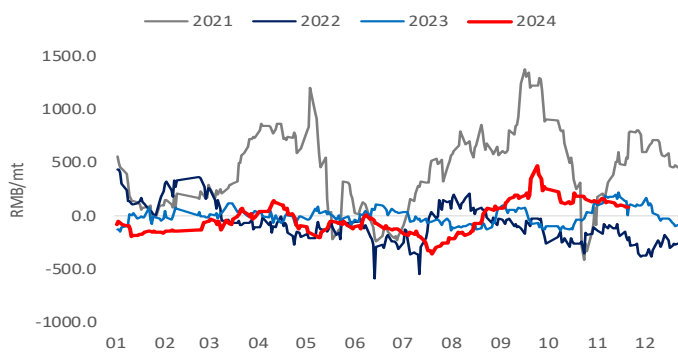

CHINESE STEEL MILL PROFITABILITY



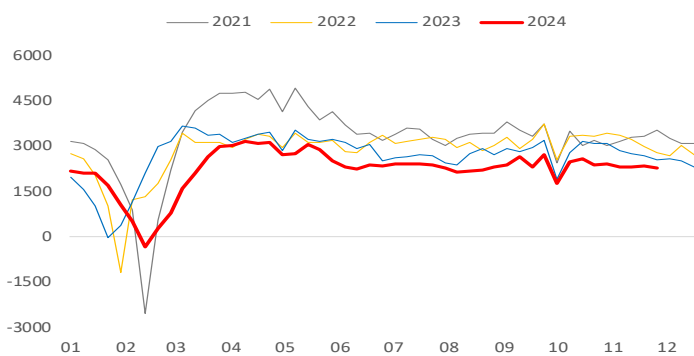
CHINESE STEEL MILL PROFITABILITY—Rebar



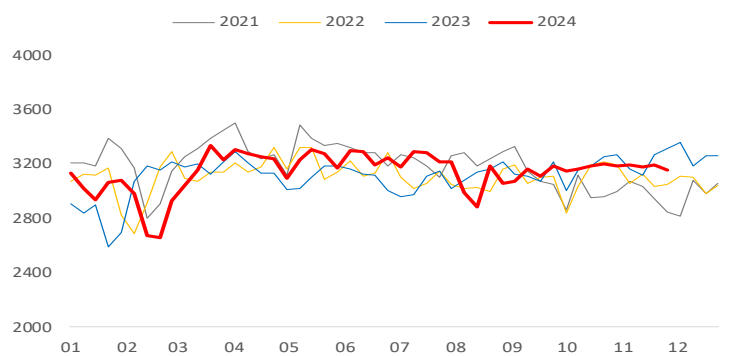
CHINESE STEEL MILL PROFITABILITY—Hot-rolled Coil



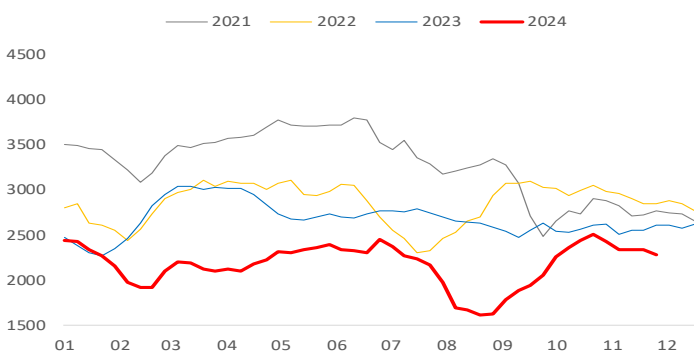

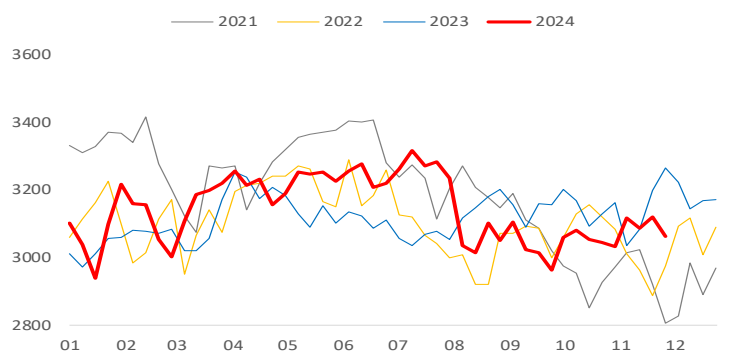

## IRON ORE DOMESTIC CONCENTRATE INDEX CALCULATION METHODOLOGY

The compilation method for price index generally refers to the compilation method of CPI price index and other price indices, breakdown the price data and calculate the average value according to a certain method, taking the vertical axis as the regional composite index (average of different grade index) and the horizontal axis as the grade composite index (average of different regional index), a total composite index for domestic ore can be output ultimately. The process system is also adopted in the calculation i.e. each sub-index can be obtained as well.
