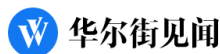

Background

- **Secondary lead** has come under the spotlight in recent years, especially in 2018-2020 when new or expanded projects are expected to come online. Policies such as the *Action Plan for Lead-acid Battery Scrap Pollution Control* and the *Standards for Lead-acid Battery Scrap Recycling*, are driving the secondary lead sector to optimise and upgrade. Will new capacity ramp up as expected in 2019? How will the new policies fare? Will standardised secondary lead be deliverable for futures contracts?
- **Lead-acid batteries** also see new policies, including the *Safety Technical Specification for Electric Bicycles*, *Interim Administrative Measures over Recycling and Re-use of New Energy Vehicle Power Battery Scrap*. A poor auto market and the rise of 5G also plays a role. How will the sector perform in 2019? Riding on the extended producer responsibility (EPR) plan, lead-acid battery producers ventured into battery scrap recycling and secondary lead smelting. Will those operations become new profit drivers?
- Shanghai lead has been trending downwards since it hit a high of 22,940 yuan/mt in late 2016. Where will it go and how will supply and demand fare in 2019?
- What are the challenges and opportunities that face producers of secondary lead and lead-acid battery in 2019, amid greater environmental pressures and changing supply and demand. We are pleased to invite you to the 2019 SMM Secondary Lead & Lead-acid Battery Summit for a discussion.
